



Nativity School's Aftercare Program is offered to working parents of students in PreK-2 (must be fully potty-trained) through Grade 8. Parents interested in this program should review the following information carefully.

HOURS

After school till 6:00 p.m. **Important: Students must be picked up by 6:00 p.m. Out of consideration for the aftercare staff and their families, please arrange a "Plan B" for pick up in case circumstances arise that prohibit the regular pick up of your children. If you are arranging alternative pick up for your children, please contact 954-987-3301 ext. 235 or email gschweser@nativitysch.com. Remind those picking up to be prepared to present ID when signing your child out.**

FEES

Weekly:	\$75.00 one child per week \$100 two children per week \$120.00 three children per week
Daily:	\$25.00 one child per day \$40.00 two children per day \$50 three children per day
Hourly:	\$10 one child per hour \$15 two children per hour \$20 three children per hour

All families must set up an invoice with auto-pay on FACTS for incidental expenses. Aftercare fees will be invoiced the following week of attendance. Payments will be automatically withdrawn 10 days from the date of invoicing. Children may not be permitted to remain in the program if the account is in arrears.

ATTENDANCE

Parents are responsible to notify both Mrs. Schweser (gschweser@nativitysch.com 954-987-3301 ext. 235) and the homeroom teacher if their son/daughter will not be attending the program on a scheduled day. Students remain in their homeroom until the "all call" after safe dismissal is complete. They then proceed to line up with the aftercare staff.

LOCATION

Aftercare for PreK students is held in the classrooms of the Murnane building. Pick up is through the south gate of the picnic area outside the parish hall.

Aftercare for grades K-5 is held in the parish hall. Pick up is through the south gates of the picnic area outside the parish hall.

Parents of PreK and Gr. 1-5 should park in the spaces on the south side of the picnic area. Access is off of W. Chaminade Dr. and Buchanan.

Aftercare for grades 6-8 will be held in Mrs. Roberts classroom, JH204, until 5:30 p.m. After 5:30 the students will be taken to the Parish Hall.

PreK Students

Accidents do happen. Please send in a complete change of clothes (t-shirt, shorts, under garments, and socks). These do not have to be uniform. Please place the items in a Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name and "Aftercare". Send with your child the first day of school.

Snack

Time will be provided after regular school dismissal for snack time. Snacks must be brought from home. Due to the prevalence of peanut allergies, we ask that non-nut snacks be sent.

Study Time

Students in grades 1-8 will be provided time to complete independent practice. Aftercare staff will provide assistance with directions and insure an environment appropriate for studying. **Tutoring is not provided.** Parents are encouraged to review the completed work to monitor their daughter/son's progress and skill development. Any concerns about your child's academic progress should be discussed with the student's teacher. Students are allowed to play educational games on their chromebooks if available.

Conduct

Students are expected to maintain respectful behavior and attitudes to their fellow students and teachers. Failure to maintain appropriate respectful behavior may result in the student's suspension or removal from the program. All Nativity School rules will be enforced at Aftercare.

Medications

Students with allergies or other medical conditions that require medication must provide a separate authorization and supply of medication in a labeled bottle with all instructions for administration. This must be in addition to what may be in the school clinic for the school day. Medication may not be given without medical authorization and is not available from the school clinic after dismissal.

After School Activities

Students, with parental authorization, are allowed to participate in after school activities. Please submit a letter authorizing the student's participation in the club/activity. Please notify the moderator of the club to make sure that they know that the student must be taken to aftercare after the activity.

Release of Students

Children will not be released to anyone other than the parent unless the parent has notified the daycare staff. Identification must be provided.

Toys/Games From Home

Unless notice is given, toys, games, and other belongings from home should not be brought to aftercare.
